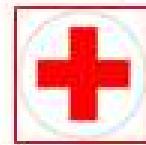

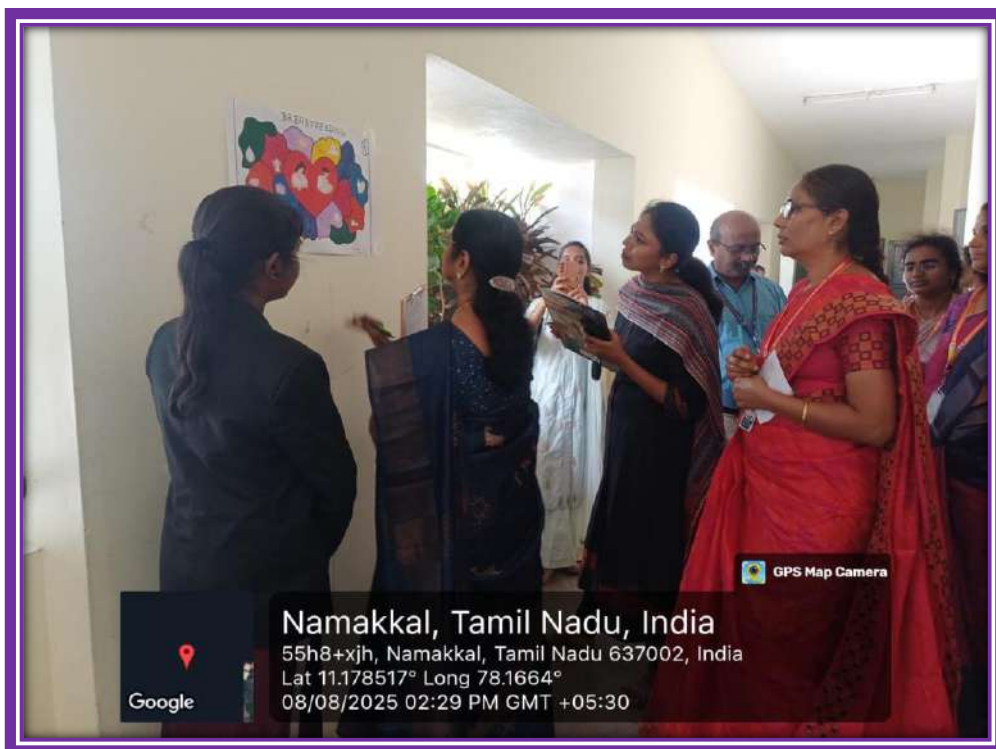
23 students of Trinity College for Women took part in the cooking competition and 21 students participated in the breastfeeding poster presentation competition.
