Koha is an open source integrated library system, used world-wide by public, school and special libraries. The name comes from a Māori term for a gift or donation.

It is an Integrated Library System with a range of features including: Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) module which provides a simple and clear interface for library users to perform tasks such as searching for and reserving items and suggesting new items.

It includes modules for acquisitions, circulation, cataloging, serials management, authorities, flexible reporting, label printing, multi-format notices, offline circulation for when Internet access is not available.

Koha has most of the features that would be expected in an ILS, including:

- ❖ Various Web 2.0 facilities like tagging, comment, social sharing and RSS feeds.
- Union catalog facility.
- Customizable search.
- Online circulation.
- ❖ Bar code printing.
- ❖ Patron card creation.
- * Report generation.
- ❖ Patron self registration form through OPAC.
