“Be Enthusiastic! Ban Plastic”

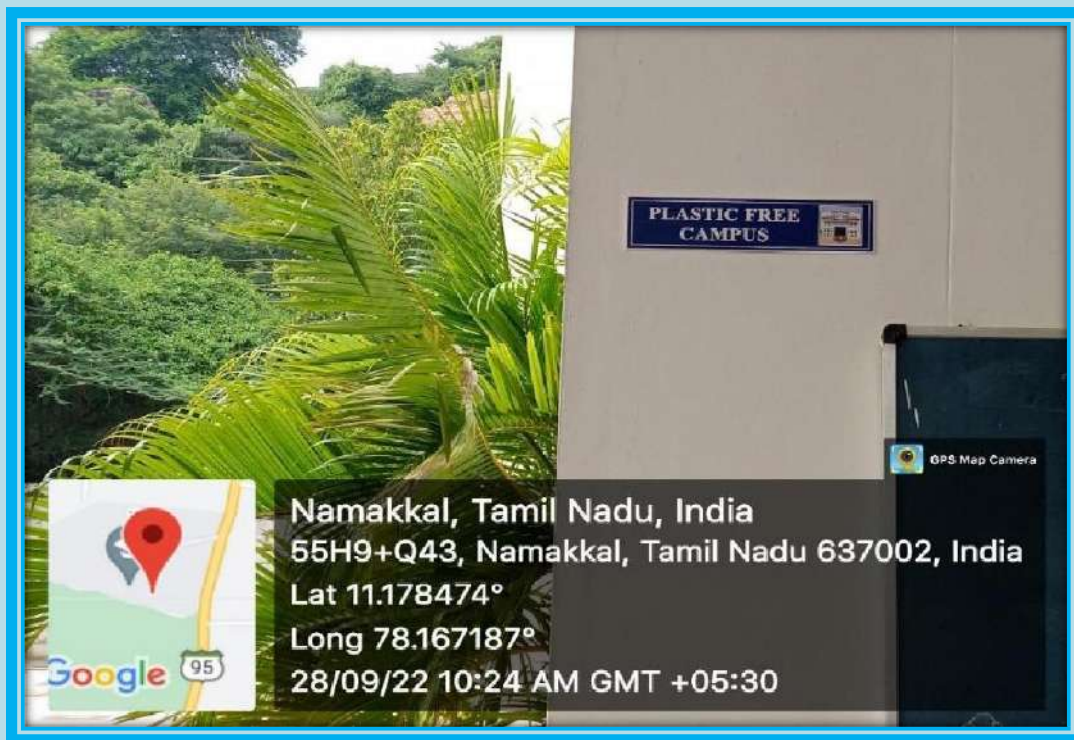
Go green, plastic should not be seen.

Stop making plastic a habit!

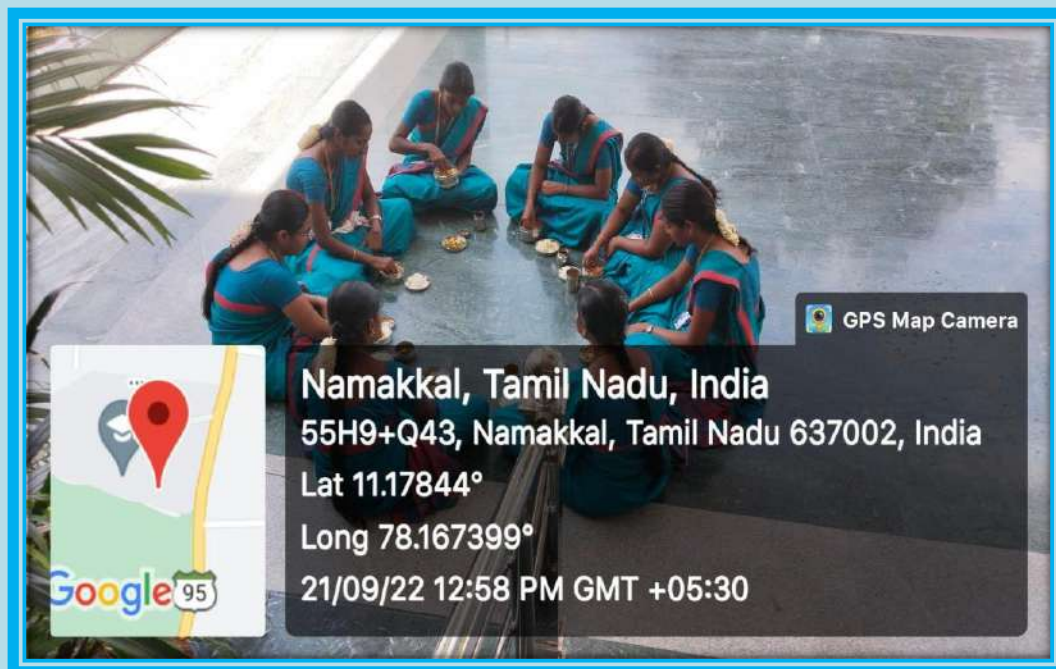
