
CELEBRATION OF WORLD EARTH DAY



The main and major sources of air pollution in Delhi include vehicle exhaust, heavy industry for example power generation, small scale industries like brick kilns, suspended dust on the roads bec ause vehicle movement and construction activities, open waste burning, combination of fuels for cooking, lighting and heating as well as in – sit power generation via diesel generator sets, she indicated. For the past few years, its pollution has been reduced on account of amendment of strict rules in Delhi Union Territory, she said.
