Webinar on “Traditions of Tamilians and New Education Policy”

Date: 09.11.2020

The New Education Policy (NEP 2020) contributes to growth and drives the education needs and requirements of our youth and younger population in India. It leads to better learning and employment outcomes and higher quality of results for the younger generation. NEP 2020 will formulate a new paradigm in Education system of India. We have 3.74 Crores Students are registered in 51,649 institutions with a GER (Gross Enrollment Ratio) of 26.3. In accordance with the MHRD (Ministry of Human Resource Development) 2018-19 report 91 lakhs students graduate per year. NEP 2020 targets to raise the Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) in higher education including vocational curriculum from 26.3% (2018) to 50% by 2035. 3.5 Crore new seats will be enhanced to Higher education institutions.

On this subject, National Service Scheme, Youth Red Cross and Red Ribbon Club of Trinity College for Women (Arts and Science), Namakkal, Tamil Nadu state has organized a one day webinar entitled “Traditions of Tamilians and New Education Policy” on 09th November 2020. This event was held through the Google Meet of video conferencing.

In this regard, Dr. D. Umadevi, Associate Professor, Department of Modern Indian Languages and Literary Studies (MIL & LS), University of Delhi, Chhatra Marg, University Enclave, New Delhi – 110 007 was the invited speaker.

The best part and role of Tamil society is that the local people are deeply rooted in their traditions and culture. They have preserved their traditions extremely very well. Even the youth and younger population are attached to their traditions and religion. Especially, our Tamil Culture is one of the oldest and richest cultures; it has a prolonged shaped history and an ancient heritage. There are many festivals and celebrations which happen in Tamil Nadu state each year. However, this traditional culture is now being impacted by westernization and every single thing is gradually changing and is becoming western, she denoted it.

Apart from that she indicated the positives and favor of new education policy-2020.

These are: 1. The New Educational Policy supports the students to upgrade their multilingual knowledge by learning many other languages like Hindi, Sanskrit, Telugu, Marathi, Bengali, Gujarati, Punjabi, Kannada, Malayalam, etc., beside that their mother language (Tamil) and English

2. This policy will also prolong its helping hand towards the students to procure their certificates at the end of each and every year in the due course of their graduation period of either 3 years or 4 years.

3. By means of excess allotment of funds from our Central Government for online education, research & development, innovative pedagogy and education, SWAYAM, etc., it widely and largely helps the students to upgrade their skills.

4. The New Education Policy highlights more importance for Professional Courses like Physical Education, Law, Agriculture, Medicine, and like this.

5. Apart from these, The New Education Policy also facilitates the adults to pursue the education which indeed results in higher literacy rate

6. The motivation and encouragement of the Staff Development Programme and formation of PARAKH (Performance, Assessment, Review and Analysis of Knowledge for Holistic Development) will enlarge the standard and grade of Education.

7. By giving Autonomous/University status to the educational institutions, it paves the way for various innovative ideas and new technologies.

8. As this policy proposes and plans the uniform education standard and courses of study throughout the nation, the students can continue their studies wherever they go.

9. The new education policy tends to provide a kick at the cat of new employment and several new entrepreneurship to start their own venture.

10. The memorization of subjects will be substituted for knowledge oriented curriculum.

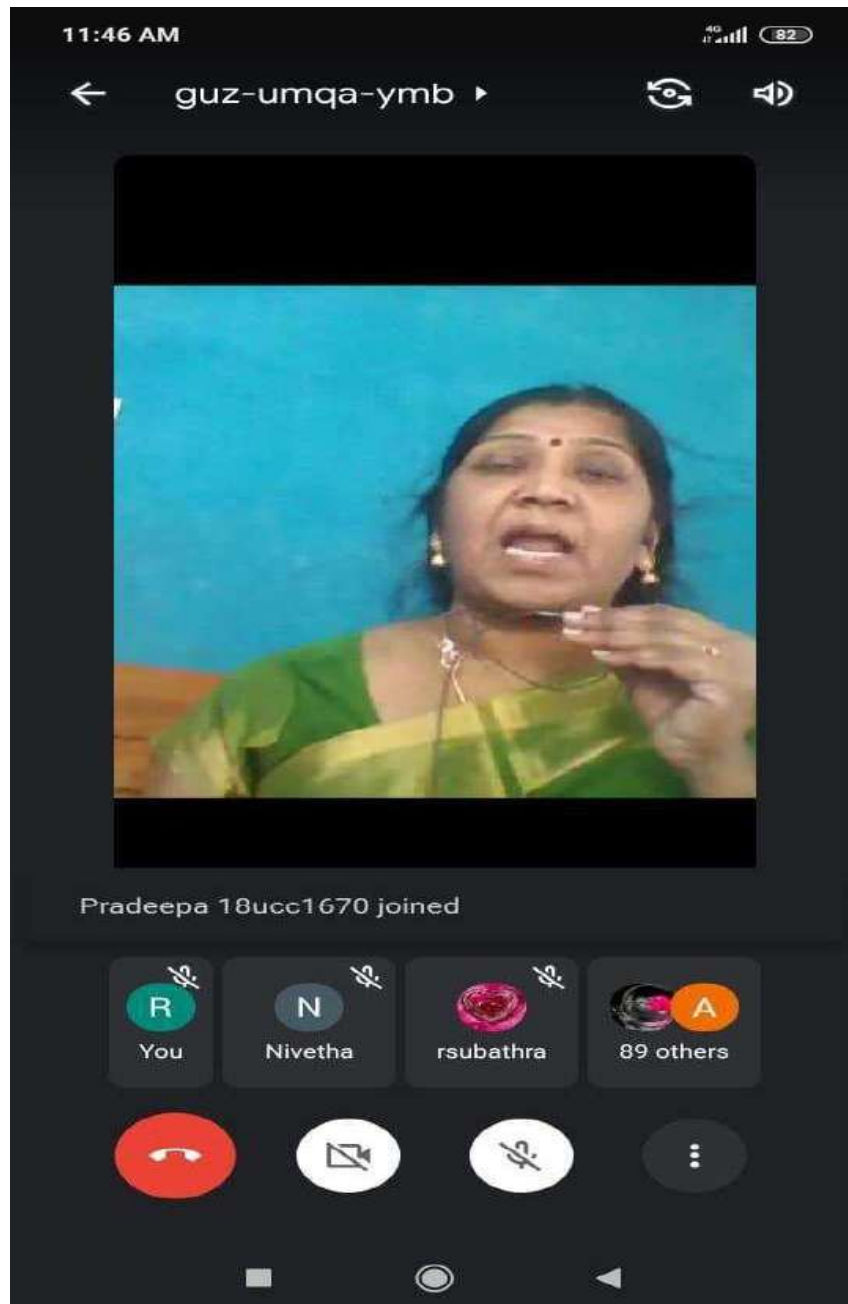
11. De facto, the Government of India will provide additional funds to State Governments for this new education system.

12. Establishment of professional Standard Setting Bodies start an undertaking for the educational institutions to guide the students in a certain way so that it can meet the needs and fulfill the Business Firms who are the job providers.


Mr. P.K. Sengodan, Chairman and Er. K. Nallusamy, Secretary of the College have forwarded their wishes to all the participants.

The CWMI report says that within the ballpark, 70% of water is contaminated. India ranks 120th position of 122 countries in a global quality index, Er K. Nallusamy, Secretary of the College indicated.

As we all know about the coronavirus, it is a global epidemic. People are in a panic. Schools, Colleges and Universities are locked. Roads are closed. Towns and Cities are protected and everybody has to sit in their house with their family members. So, this is a very crucial time, he spoke.

Use of 4 Ayurveda medicines – Ayuth Kwatha, Sanshamnivati, Fifatrol Tablets and Laxmi Vilasa Rasa are much benefitted for patients of coronavirus, he intimated.

Besides that, he gave some tips for prevention of COVID 19

- Mix up a pinch of turmeric and salt in hot water with Yashtimadhu (Licorice) and Triphala; use this concoction to gargle once or twice every day.
- Apply coconut oil, sesame oil, cow’s ghee or medicated oils in our nostrils, particularly before going out and after coming back home.
- Add on carom seeds, mint leaves or eucalyptus oil to water and do steam inhalation everyday using this concoction.
- Chewing clove at regular intervals.
- To drink more water frequently
- Get 6 to 8 hours of sleep every night; do moderate exercises daily and follow a healthy and balanced diet. Add herbs and spices like ginger, cumin, coriander and holy basil in our diet.


