TRINITY COLLEGE FOR WOMEN (ARTS AND SCIENCE), NAMAKKAL, represented by its **PRINCIPAL** (which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in – office, administrators and assigns), the party of the Second Part.

- a) WHEREAS, The party of the First Part and the party of the Second Part believe that, collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- b) Both the Parties intend to co-operate and shed focus on their efforts to forge co-operation within the area of E-learning, Education and Skill based Training and Research.
- c) This institutional collaboration is made purely for academic purposes and as part of the **Major Research Project (MJ-RP-139)**, sponsored by the **Indian Council for Social Science Research (ICSSR), New Delhi** and carried out by Dr.R.Subramaniya Bharathy, Associate Professor, Department of Management Studies, Periyar University, Salem.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this MOU, the parties hereto agree as follows:

Clause 1

Co-operation

2.3 The Research Study Collaboration includes Awareness-Cum-Orientation programmes on E-learning methods and tools and Faculty Training Workshops on various competencies and skills related to e-learning, teaching and e-content development.

2.4 This is a voluntary collaboration and there are no any financial commitments on the part of both the parties.

Clause 3

Validity

3.1 The agreement is valid for a Period between **28.12.2020** and **27.12.2021** or until it is expressly terminated by either party on mutually agreed terms.


Clause 4


Relationship between the parties

independent contractors and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither party shall have nor represent itself as having any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other party to pledge such other party's credit or to extend credit on behalf of such other party.

Abstract

More or less 48% of population is female in India. Agonizingly, just 14% of women's are engaged in this entrepreneurship.
