## Chairman's Message:

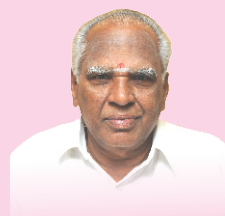

Our Vision is to build a casteless and classless society, imparting quality education to women and paving the way for women's empowerment, enhancing their capability and making India a "GREAT NATION".

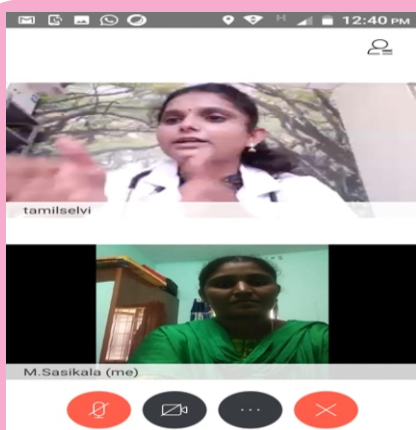

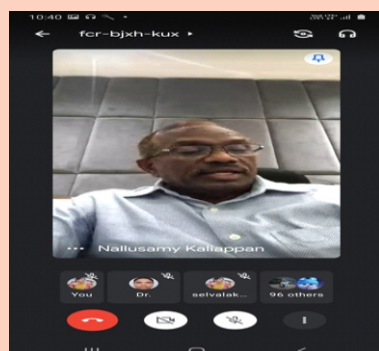
