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INTRODUCTION

- Fashion design is the art of drawing, aesthetics and functionality to clothing and its accessories. Designers work in various ways in the design of clothing and accessories such as bags, shoes, hats, jewelry and costume jewelry.

Balance

- **Balance** in fashion design can be achieved with the use of features such as seams, hemlines, and necklines

Symmetrical balance



Types Of Balance

- *Formal balance –symmetry*

Design has equal elements on both sides

- *Informal balance –asymmetry*

Design has varying elements and spaces on both sides



Asymmetrical balance

Rhythm

- The pleasing arrangement of the design elements so the eye moves well over the apparel. It directs the flow of eye movement.
- Repetition: Can be a repeat of lines, shapes, colors, or textures
- Gradation: Also called progression. An increase or decrease in design elements.
- Transition: A fluid rhythm created when a curved line leads the eye over an angle.
- Opposition: When lines meet to form right angles.
- Radial Arrangement: Lines come from a central point.



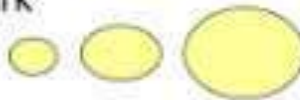
Rhythm-Gradation

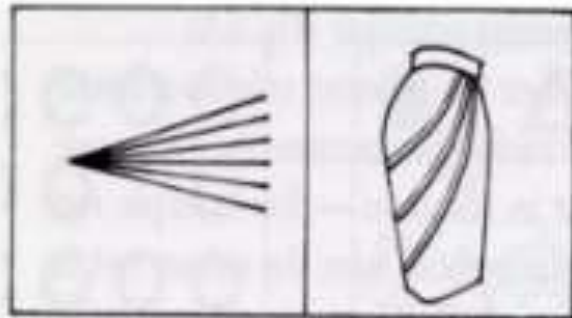

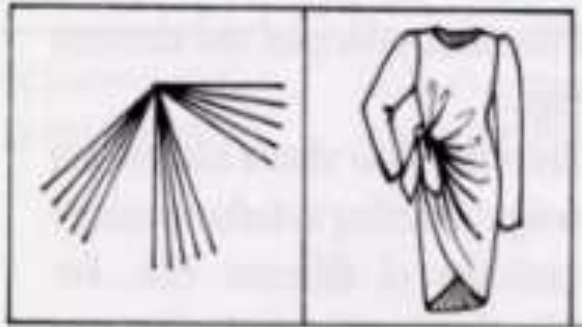


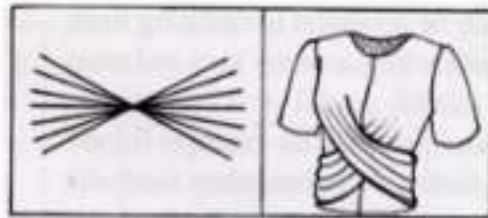
Rhythm- Radiation

Lines flow out from a single point.

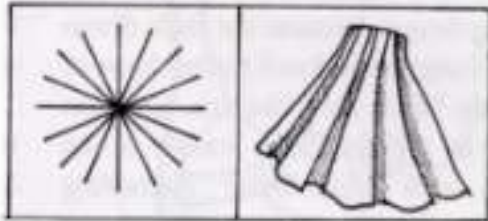


Similar directions

Rhythm- Transition

- Curved lines carry the eye.



Emphasis

Emphasis means the interest is concentrated in a particular part or area of a design. Emphasis in clothing may be achieved with contrasts of colours or textures, lines, or unusual shapes.



PROPORTION

- Proportion is the **relationship** between objects, or parts, of a whole.
- The size, relationship of all of the parts in a design to each other and to the whole. Also called “scale”.
- Size and scale are important aspects of proportion.
Proportion means the size of a part in relation to the size of the whole.



HARMONY

- **Harmony** means that there is pleasing visual unity of all aspects of a design. It is a summary of all of the other elements and principles of design. It means that all parts of the design look as if they belong. There is no excess variation that could displease or detract from appreciating the entire design or look.
