#### HISTORY OF TEXTILE INDUSTRY




#### ANCIENT INDIA

India is a country in South Asia whose name comes from the Indus River. The name 'Bharata' is used as a designation for the country in their constitution referencing the ancient mythological emperor, Bharata, whose story is told, in part, in the Indian epic *Mahabharata*.

#### **MEDIVAL INDIA**

**Medieval India** refers to a long period of post-classical history of the Indian subcontinent between the "ancient period" and "modern period". It is usually regarded as running approximately from the breakup of the Gupta Empire in the 6th century CE to the start of the early modern period in 1526 with the start of the Mughal Empire although some historians regard it as both starting and finishing later than these points. The medieval period is itself subdivided into the early medieval and late medieval eras.

#### TURKISH TEXTILE HISTORY

As far back as the year 1502, Busra was the hub for the Ottoman Empire's textile market, and as all textiles belonged to the royal family their sale and manufacture were controlled by the state. Any Turkish textile merchant had to follow rules and procedures to sell their wares in Busra, and those who disobeyed these laws were met with swift retribution. The rules all textile merchants adhered to were found in the **ihtisab kanunameleri**, and most of the procedures listed in this manual were explicit in their requirements.
