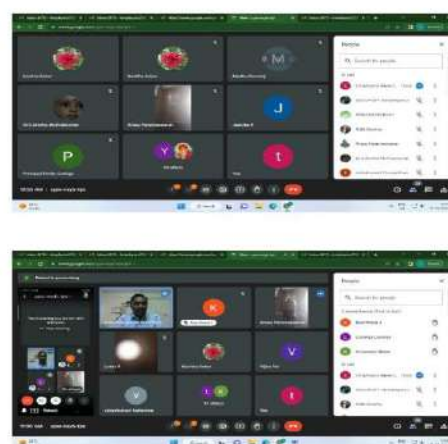
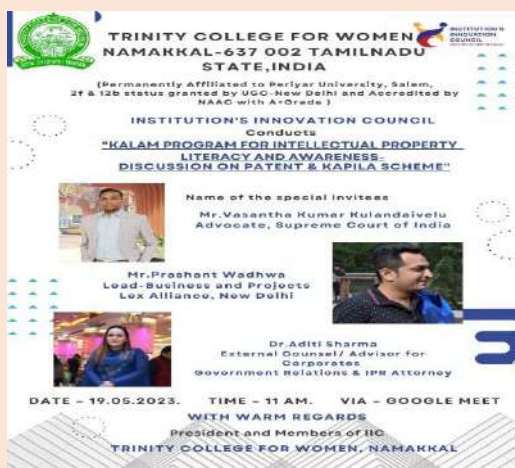

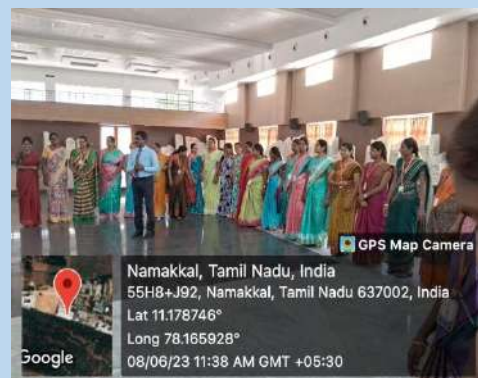
STUDY NOW BE PROUD LATER
