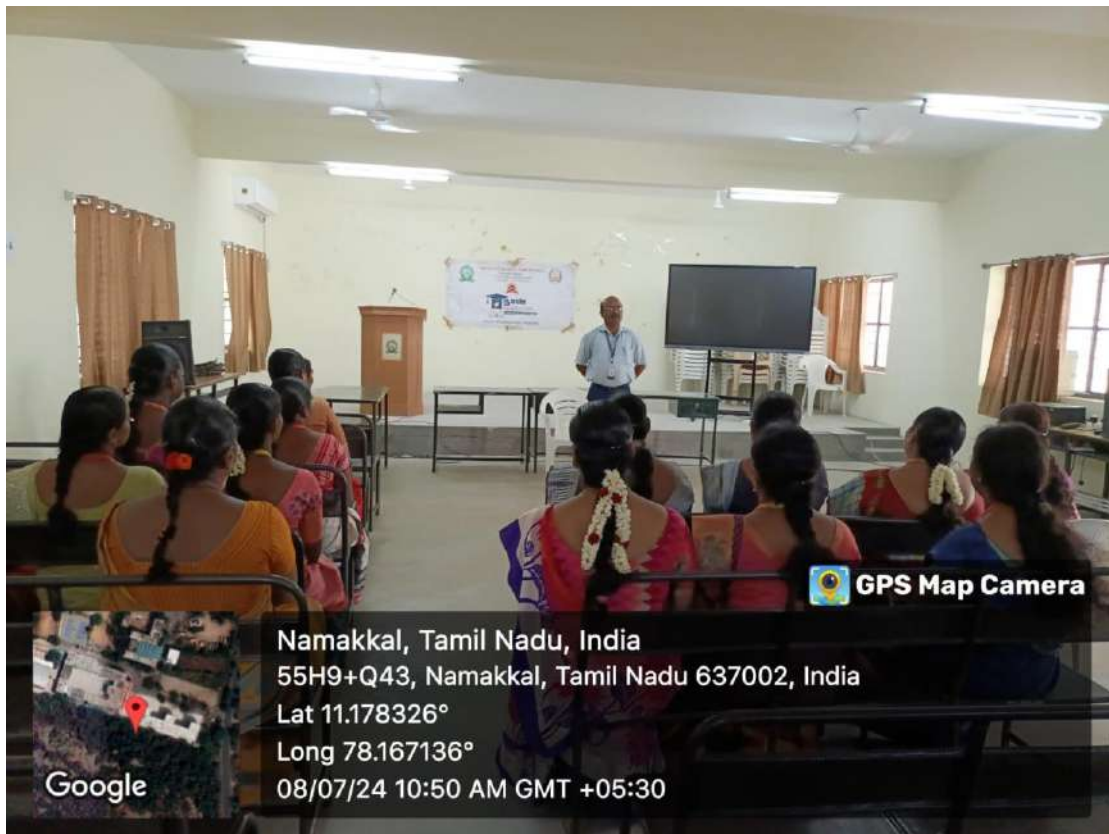


Naan Mudhalvan action plan program
