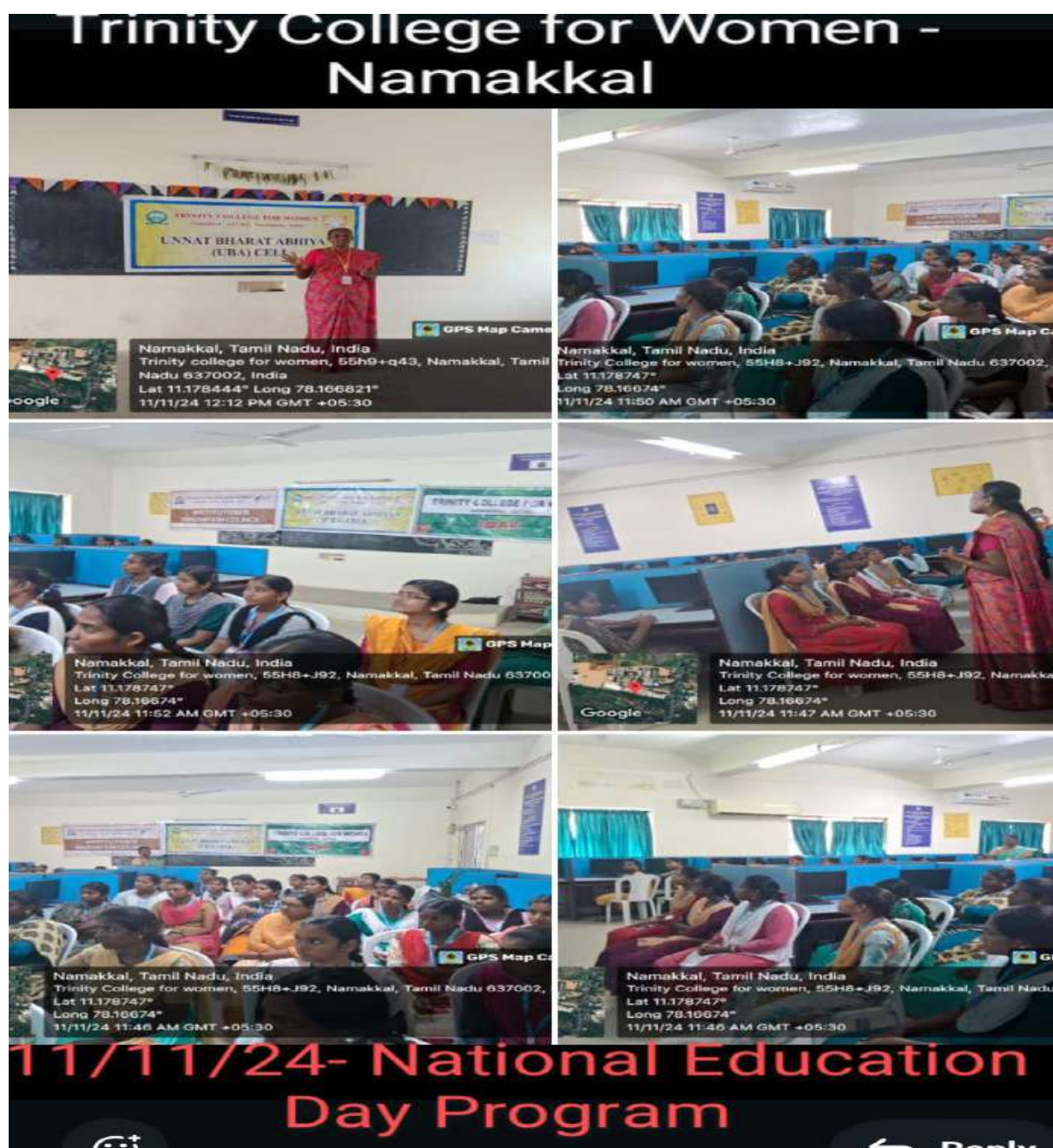

(9) UBA Orientation cum Guidance Meeting

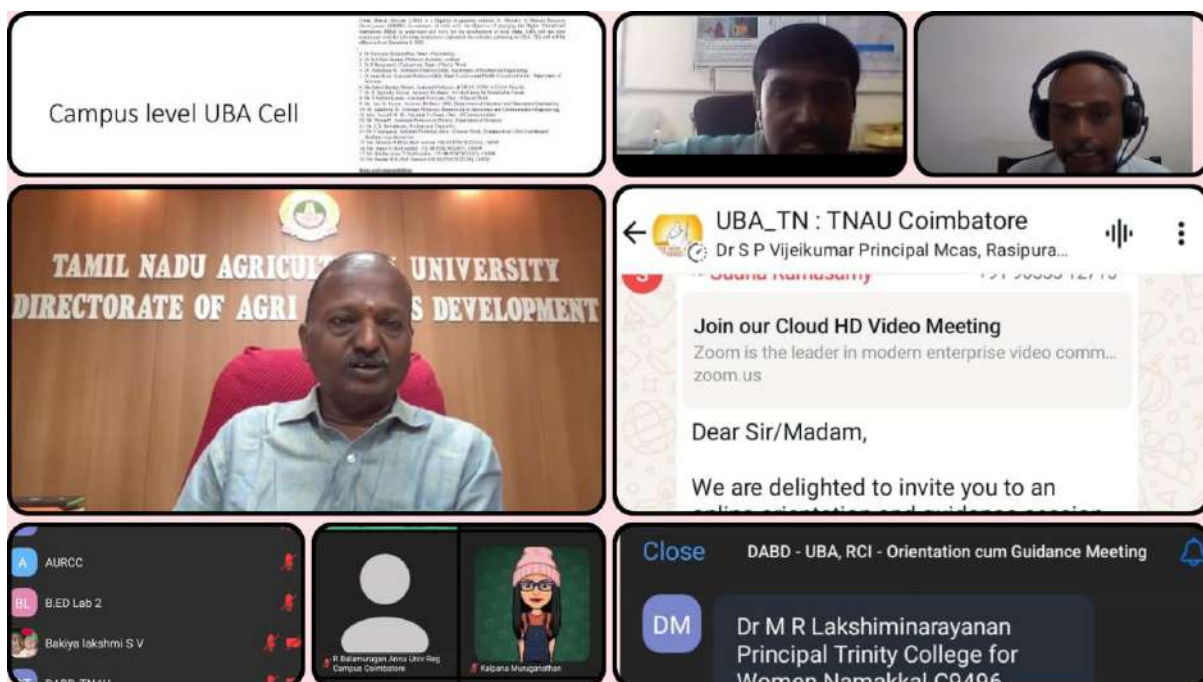

(10) Celebration of Constitution Day of India – (26th November 2024).

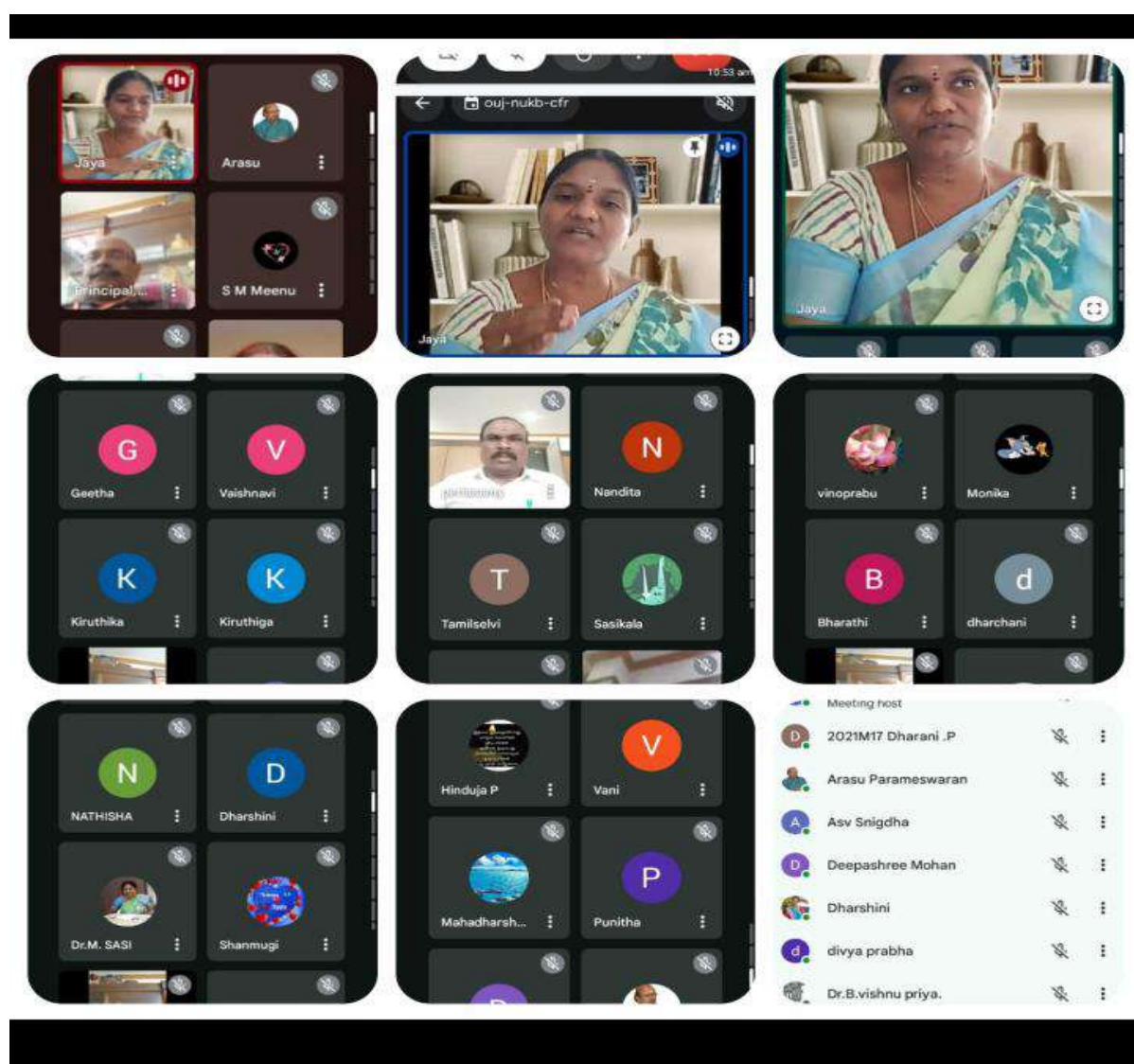

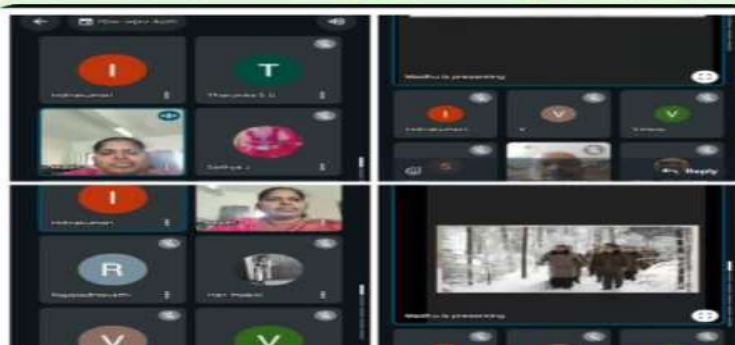
