Sardar Vallabhai Patel was a great leader who played an instrumental role in India's struggle for independence. He did a commendable job of uniting these states with the Union of India, she said.

















(8) Celebration of National Education Day – 11th November 2024



(9) UBA Orientation cum Guidance Meeting



(10) Celebration of Constitution Day of India – (26th November 2024).



Nearly, 100 students took part in that programme.






(12)Observation of international soil day


(13) Free Eye Screening Camp
